FISHING PEGS INFORMATION

Llyn Brenig

Peg 1

Peg 1 is situated in the Llyn Brenig Sailing Club area behind the moored boats. There is access for parking at the top of the peg with a small, although quite steep, 30 meter walk down to the pegged area.

The water in front of Peg 1 is clear of large snags with a number of small to large boulders littering the bottom around 20 meters out. The water depth around the boats when the lake is full is approximately 15 feet deep.

Peg 1 would be calm water on a south wind and likewise very windy on a north wind!

Peg 2

Peg 2 is situated towards the far end of the sailing club bay. Once again there is a good car park space at the top of the peg marked with a number 2.

There is a rather steep but short walk down from the car park area to the peg with suitable room for brollies and bivvies alike.

The water in front of Peg 2 has slightly more depth in places reaching nearly 18 feet but with a slow and gradual drop.

The water to the left of the peg does get fairly shallow with a depth of around 8 feet however there can be some hidden snags so better to have baited rods out in front rather than to the left.

Peg 2 would be calm water on a south or westerly wind and like would remain fairly calm on north wind also.

Peg 3

Peg 3 is situated opposite Peg 2 still in Sailing Club bay. The parking for Peg 3 is actually found on the left hand side of the road marked again with a post. The track down to the peg is then opposite the car park space.

The walk to the peg itself is around 150 meters. The ground is flat and easy to walk so good for wheel barrows and such.

The peg has a wide spread of water in front of it ranging from small rocky shallows on the left through to 20 feet of water right out in front and again small weedy shallows on the right. This would be perfect for fishing more than 2 rods.

Peg 3 is a fairly open peg so there is a possibility for it to get windy on both easterly and north winds however will be sheltered in a west wind.

Peg 4

Peg 4 is situated in Water sports Bay marked with Post 4. There is a large car park space for numerous cars here with a picnic bench also.

Once down through the trees, approximately 40 meters, to the pegged area there is enough room for a broolly or a small bivvy with fairly flat ground and sufficient casting space behind.

The water in front has numerous large weed beds consisting of Canadian pond weed and a number of mosses and grasses. There a small number snags to the far right and far left of the peg so best to keep baited rods out in front. It has a slow but gradual gradient with castable water reaching around 12 to 15 feet due to the bottom being uneven. A definite pike hotspot!

Peg 5

Peg 5 is situated at the bottom of the slip road just into Brenig Arm marked again with a post at the top of the road down. There is sufficient car park space for 2 cars at the end of the track.

Due to the car park space being right next to the peg there is no need to walk with all the tackle and makes things slightly easier for all ages and abilities.

Feels very secluded as no roads can be seen from this peg. This peg will stay calm in pretty much all conditions except an easterly wind which can get quite blustery here.

The water in front of the peg has a wide range of features from a very steep and snaggy sloop on the left hand bank and a very silty clear bank on the right. The water right in front of the peg can reach some serious depth at a fair distance approximately 20 + meters!

Peg 6

Peg 6 is found on the bend of Brenig Arm going into the shallow end of the arm. The parking is marked at the top with a post and a number 6.

There is a clear but steep walk down to the peg of around 50 meters so please be careful in wet weather. Once down to the pegged area the ground is fairly uneven and there is only room for 1 or 2 brollies.

Brenig arm is usually calm in most winds however there is a possibility that the easterly breeze may reach this peg.

The water is fairly similar to that of Peg 5 with some good deep water out in front to about 25 feet with some lovely snaggy side banks to the left and right. As this is the bend of the arm any fish moving through here have to pass in front of this point making it a great pick up point to catch any moving pike.

Peg 7

Peg 7 is found right towards the end of the Brenig Arm. Once again marked with a post and a number 7. There is a good carp park space found at the top of the peg again with a steep 50 meter walk down to the peg through the trees. Please be careful in wet weather.

The ground is good enough for 1 bivvy or 2 brollies if needed.

Once again the water in front of you has some depth in front to around 18 feet with a very steep drop of located right at the bank. A lot of work has been done to remove the large snags here however a few remain on the far left and far right of the peg so please be aware.
