

Pike

FISHING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Llyn Brenig, Llyn Alwen and Llyn Aled

Anglers must book at least a day in advance. During this period no boats out before 9am, all boats must be back on the jetty by 3pm.

Rules 1, 2, 3, 8, 11, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 29, 30 and 31 from the normal trout fishing Terms and Conditions also apply to all pike anglers.

Between July 1st and October 31st, Pike fishing is by fly only, and following terms apply:

- 1. Permits**
All Brenig pike fishing is from boat only.
- 2. No anchoring**
- 3. No trolling**
(Boat must not be under power either by oars or engine(s) when the fly is in the water.)
- 4. Hooks (Fly)**
All hooks must be barbless or de-barbed. Hook size for fly must be a minimum size 4 or larger.
Single hooks only, no doubles and trebles. Maximum of one fly per cast.
- 5. Other**
Every angler must fill in a catch return at the end of their fishing day. Only one rod in use by an angler at one time. However there is no limit as to how many rods are set up in the boat.
Electronic fish finding devices are permitted.
- 6. The fish**
ALL pike must be safely returned to the water. All anglers must be competent in fish welfare.
No trout species may be targeted or captured.
- 7. Trout caught accidentally to be returned**
Any that need despatching due to being badly hooked are to be declared and handed over to the rangers. The option to keep the trout will be given at a rate of £1 per 1lb the trout weighs.

PIKE FISHING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The following rules apply to pike fishing in the winter, from November 1st to February 28th.

Random checks will be carried out through the day, when on the water and on the jetty.

8. **Any lures (plugs, spinners, fly) must be at least 15.2cm long (6inches)**
9. **Hook size**
All hooks must be barbless or de-barbed. Minimum size 6 in Treble hooks. All other hooks must at least be size 4 or larger (i.e. size 1).
10. **Bait**
Dead Sea baits only, no Lamprey or Smelt.
11. **NO Trolling through use of Brenig Engines**
12. **Anchoring allowed (own anchors must be supplied)**
13. **Other**
Every angler must fill in a catch return at the end of their fishing day.
One rod in use by an angler at one time.
However there is no limit as to how many rods are set up in the boat.
Electronic fish finding devices are permitted.
14. **The fish**
ALL pike must be safely returned to the water. All anglers must be competent in fish welfare.
No trout species may be targeted or captured.
15. **Trout caught accidentally to be returned**
Any that need despatching due to being badly hooked are to be declared and handed over to the Rangers. The option to keep the trout will be given at a rate of £1 per 1lb the trout weighs.

CONTRAVENTION OF RULES

Any angler committing an offence under the Salmon and Freshwater Fisheries Act 1975, the byelaws made under the Act, or contravening these terms and conditions may be liable to prosecution, or may, at the discretion of the Manager, be barred from fishing the reservoir or any other waters owned by the Company. Where such bans are made, no refund will be given. Please report any suspicious activities to a member of staff.

RESERVED POWER

Dŵr Cymru Welsh Water reserves the right to close all or part of the reservoir to anglers at any time without giving prior notice to permit holders. Anglers should note that certain areas of the reservoir may be closed to fishing at times when other sporting events are in progress. The Manager's decision is final on all matters connected with the fishing and the interpretation of the rules and regulations.
