FISHING PEGS INFORMATION

Llyn Brenig

Peg 1

Located near the Llyn Brenig Sailing Club area at the bottom of the slip road close to the exit hairpin. Parking spaces available, waterside fair access for wheelchair (Max 2 people).

Peg 1 would be calm water on a south wind and very windy on a north wind.

Peg 2

Situated towards the far end of the Sailing Club Bay. There is a good car park space.

There is a rather steep but short walk down from the car park area to the peg with suitable room for brollies and bivvies.

Peg 2 would be calm water on a south or westerly wind and would remain calm on north wind.

Peg 3

Situated opposite Peg 2 in Sailing Club Bay. The parking for Peg 3 is found on the left-hand side of the road marked with a post. The track down to the peg is opposite the car park space.

The walk to the peg itself is around 150 metres. The ground is flat and easy to walk so good for wheelbarrows etc.

Peg 3 is an open peg so there is a possibility for it to get windy on both easterly and north winds however will be sheltered in a west wind.

Peg 4

Situated in Watersports Bay marked with a post. There is a large car park space for several cars and a picnic bench.

Approximately 40 metres down through the trees, to the pegged area there is enough room for a brolly or a small bivvy with flat ground and sufficient casting space behind.

Peg 5

Situated at the bottom of the slip road just into Brenig Arm marked with a post at the top by the road down. There is sufficient car park space for 2 cars at the end of the track.

Due to the car park space being right next to the peg there is no need to walk with all the tackle and makes things slightly easier for all ages and abilities.

Feels very secluded as no roads can be seen from this peg. This peg will stay calm in pretty much all conditions except an easterly wind which can get quite blustery here.

Peg 6

There is a steep walk down through the forest. Parking available at Peg start. Not wheelchair accessible (Max 2 people).

Very sheltered peg and calm water only affected from north wind.

Peg 7

Found on the bend of Brenig Arm going into the shallow end of the arm. The parking is marked at the top with a post.

There is a clear but steep walk down to the peg of around 50 metres so please be careful in wet weather. Once down to the pegged area the ground is uneven and there is only room for 1 or 2 brollies.

Brenig arm is usually calm in most winds however there is a possibility that the easterly breeze may reach this peg.

Peg 8

Found towards the end of the Brenig Arm and marked with a post. There is a good car park space found at the top of the peg with a steep 50 metre walk down through the trees. Please be careful in wet weather.

The ground is good enough for 1 bivvy or 2 brollies if needed.

Peg 9

Located towards the end of the Brenig Arm Road opposite bank of Peg 7 and 8. The car park is marked with a post. The peg is placed 50 metres walk down from the car park through the trees to a large flat gravel peg. Please be cautious in wet condition. The pegged area is quite big and capable of hosting two large bivvys.

The Brenig Arm is usually calm in most winds.

Peg 10

Found at the end of the road in Brenig Arm. Signposted with parking next to the peg. Easy to access but not wheelchair friendly due to grass (max 3 people).

Peg 11

Situated on the west side of the reservoir close by the Ring Cairn area on the Nantglyn Shore. It is an open peg like most of the pegs on this side of the lake so there is the possibility for it to get windy in north and westerly wind. There is the option of parking on the grass close to water. Plenty of space for bivvys or brolly.

Peg 12

100 metres from peg 11 on the Nantglyn Shore, it has the same exposure in terms of winds. There is plenty of space for bivvys or broolly the only difference from peg 11 is that the parking is located on the road 20 metres from the peg.

Peg 13

Sited on the Hafoty Shore marked with post. There is car park space for two cars on the road with easy access to the peg. It is a quite open peg so there is a possibility to get windy in north and westerly wind.

Peg 14

Peg 14 is not far from peg 13 on the Hafoty Shore. Again, with the car park on the road close to the peg it has an easy access and plenty of space for broollys and bivvys on the grass bank. Peg 14 like peg 13 is an open peg expose to the wind only sheltered in an east wind.

Peg 15

Located on the mouth of the Llech Daniel Cove and marked with a post. The peg is located 40 metres walk from the car park through the trees to a very sheltered spot with enough space for a bivvy or two broollys.

Peg 16 and 17

Pegs 16 and 17 are located on the Hafod Lom Woods roughly 60 metres walk from the car park marked at the top with posts and numbers. These two pegs are more sheltered from south and easterly wind but they lack a nice grass bank to host large bivvys.

Peg 18

Situated between the Quarry and Tower Bay and marked with a post. The car park space is 20 metres from the peg. Peg 18 is a sheltered in most of the winds however can be windy in westerly wind.

Peg 19 and 20

Pegs 19 and 20 are close together in Tower Bay. The open space offers the possibility of comfortable car park and plenty of space for large bivvys. Tower Bay is very sheltered from most winds.
