FISHING TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Llyn Brenig and Llyn Aled

Permits

Fishing is by permit only, to be obtained in advance. A valid permit is required for each rod used. Additional permits are available.

Permits are not transferable.

Permits are available by booking online at <https://llynbrenig.com/llyn-brenig-fishing/>

By phoning 01490 389222, or in person at the Llyn Brenig Visitor Centre.

Every angler must fill in a catch return at the end of their fishing day.

Rod Licence

A fishing permit is not valid unless the holder has an appropriate Environment Agency Rod Licence.

Pike fishing by boat.

No trolling, boat must not be under power whilst fishing. Anchoring is allowed, anchors not supplied.

Fly Hooks

All hooks must be barbless or de-barbed. Hook size for fly must be a minimum size 4 or larger.

Single hooks only, no doubles and trebles. Maximum of one fly per cast.

Lure Hooks

Lures, plugs, spinners must be at least 15.2cm long (6inches)

Minimum size 6 in Treble hooks.

The Fish

All pike must be safely returned to the water. All anglers must be competent in fish welfare. Unhooking mats must be used.

No trout species may be targeted or captured.

Trout caught accidentally to be returned.

Any that need dispatching due to being badly hooked are to be declared and handed over to the rangers. The option to keep the trout will be given at a rate of £2.50 per 1lb the trout weighs.

Bait.

Dead Sea baits only, no Lamprey or Smelt.

Electronic fish finding devices are permitted.

Litter

Anglers are requested to take their litter home or use litter bins where provided.

Nylon monofilament is dangerous to wildlife and must not be discarded.

Toilet facilities

Anglers must use toilet facilities for all sanitary purposes.

GATES

To avoid escape of livestock, all gates must be closed behind you, even if you find one open.

BIOSECURITY

Only clean and well dried equipment may be used on site to prevent the spread of undesirable organisms.

For boat fishing, only the provided drogues and landing nets may be used.

No visitors are allowed on to the Llyn Brenig fish farm unless escorted by a member of staff, to minimise the biosecurity risks.

CUSTOMER BEHAVIOUR

Behaviour judged by any member of staff to be abusive, threatening, aggressive, racist, homophobic/ transphobic or sexist will not be tolerated. Nor shall willful damage

to Dwr Cymru Welsh Water property. Any visitor displaying unacceptable behavior, including but not limited to those mentioned above, will be required to vacate the site immediately and will have their permit cancelled with no refund.

All users please remember:

Dŵr Cymru Welsh Water supply drinking water to thousands of people, please do not pollute any of our waters.

Contravention of rules.

Any angler committing an offence under the Salmon and Freshwater Fisheries Act, 1975, the byelaws made under the act, or contravening these terms and conditions may be liable to prosecution, or may, at the discretion of the Manager, be barred from fishing at the reservoir or any other waters owned by Welsh Water. Where such bans are made, no refund will be given. Please report any suspicious activities to a member of staff.

Reserved Power.

Dŵr Cymru Welsh Water reserves the right to close all or part of the reservoir to anglers at any time without giving prior notice to permit holders. Anglers should note that certain areas of the reservoir may be closed to fishing at times when other events are in progress. The manager's decision is final on all matters connected with the fishing and the interpretation of the rules and regulations.

Neither Dŵr Cymru Welsh Water nor its agents, employees or servants shall be liable for any loss, injury or damage whatsoever in nature to the holder of this permit while on the property of Dŵr Cymru Welsh Water or any part thereof or while entering or leaving the same save in respect of death or personal injury caused by the negligence of Dŵr Cymru Welsh Water may suffer or incur and which arises from the holder of this permit's negligence, breach of contract or otherwise.
